To bolster its efforts to safeguard the health and safety of our partners who are part of its skeletal workforce, De La Salle Araneta University will be implementing a 4-10 work arrangement scheme for its physically reporting partners starting August 3 (Monday).

Under such scheme, the university shall divide its skeletal workforce into two groups and each group will physically report to the university for four days in a week then subject themselves to a 10-day quarantine period. Based on research from the Weizmann Institute of Science, implementation of the said scheme by businesses and organizations has been found to effectively contain any possible cases of infection among their workers while allowing them to continuously deliver essential services to their clients.

As a result of this scheme, the university will only be open from Monday to Thursday. Friday will be designated as a disinfection day, though clients may still communicate with offices and units for any immediate concern or request on the said day—albeit through purely online means.

To this end, we earnestly ask all our stakeholders for their continued patience and understanding as the implementation of the said scheme will invariably translate to longer processing times for certain transactions and service requests.
