I would like to inform the entire De La Salle Araneta University academic community that I have approved the early/optional retirement application of our University Registrar, Dr. Nelda Gene Mariano.

Dr. Mariano started her vocation in teaching as a Basic Education Department faculty in 1990. Six years into this role, she was recruited as a College of Education part-time faculty. She held the two teaching roles concurrently until March 1998.

In June of 1998, Dr. Mariano was appointed as College Guidance Counselor and Officer-in-Charge of the Guidance and Testing Center. She later served as the Coordinator for Student Development in 2003, and as Assistant to the Dean of Student Affairs in 2004. From 2005 to 2009, Dr. Mariano was the Coordinator for Student Activities and Development, as well as the Assistant Dean of the Student Affairs Office.

Her invaluable contributions to the university continued as she assumed the positions of Director of Academic Services in 2009 and University Registrar in 2013. From 2013 until her retirement day, Dr. Mariano's term as University Registrar has been marked with significant changes in the areas of enrolment processing, data management, and records keeping.

In light of Dr. Mariano's early retirement, Assistant Registrar Ms. Lenny Mendoza will be the Officer-in-Charge beginning June 18 and will remain in the said function until a suitable candidate is found. Internal applications for the University Registrar position will be open on June 18, and interested individuals may submit their application letter to the Office of the Chancellor.

Let us wish Dr. Mariano well in the journey that she will be embarking. Her contributions to the university through her many years of service have helped shape the university to what it is today.
