DLSAU Robotics Team Places 4th in the ICpEP National CpE Student

November 27, 2018

Our Tertiary Education Department Robotics Team placed fourth in the Line Follower Competition of the Institute of Computer Engineers of the Philippines, Inc. (ICpEP) National CpE Student Challenge 2018 that was held last November 27 at the University of Cordilleras in Baguio City. The team is among the 36 participating robotics groups from the 18 regions of the country.

The winners are as follows: Bulacan State University - Region 3 (First Place), University of Cordilleras - Cordillera Administrative Region (Second Place), St. Mary University of Nueva Vizcaya - Region 2 (Third Place), and De La Salle Araneta University - National Capital Region (Fourth Place).

Last October 27, the team placed first runner up in the regional eliminations of the same competition, behind Pamantasan ng Lungsod ng Maynila.
