## TESHPA Student Grant

April 22, 2019 to May 3, 2019

The Tertiary Education and Senior High School Parents Association (TESHPA) will be providing financial assistance to students through the TESHPA Student Grant for SY 2019-2020. The initiative is particularly targeted at incoming 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> year TED Students and incoming Grade 12 students from single-parent households. Below is the full list of requirements:

- a. A certificate, issued by the barangay, which states that the student comes from a single-parent household. A photocopy of the parent's Solo Parent ID should also be submitted.
- b. Certificate of Indigency, issued by DSWD
- c. Certificate of No Discipline Record
- d. Copy of Summary of Grades
- e. Monthly Narrative Report from Grant Recipient (to be submitted to the TESHPA Office)
- f. No grade requirement. However, applicant must have no NFEs, failed grades, or dropped subjects

A total of 36 slots will be given per school year, with 12 slots awarded to qualified applicants per term. Each grantee will receive P2 000 per month (P6 000/term).

Applications will be accepted from April 22 (Monday) to May 3 (Friday) and will be subject for review and evaluation by TESHPA and the Scholarships and Financial Assistance Office.
