All Senior High School (SHS), Tertiary Education Department (TED), and Graduate Studies are reminded to evaluate their professors until July 19 (Friday), whereas Night College Program (NCP) students may do so on August 15 (Thursday) to 16 (Friday). The online faculty performance evaluation facility—which provides the university with an objective assessment of its faculty's planning and preparation, classroom management, instruction and professional responsibilities—can be accessed by logging in to www.ebalwasyon-shs.dlsau.edu.ph (for SHS students) and www.ebalwasyon.dlsau.edu.ph (for TED, Graduate Studies, and NCP students).

Students may access the facility using the official DLSAU email account at any time, from any desktop or mobile device, as long as it is connected to the internet. Please note that failure to evaluate your professors will result to you being blocked from viewing your grades.
