Annual Physical Examination

March 15 and March 16, 2018

The university is very particular with the health of its personnel and believes that personnel efficiency and effectiveness are greatly affected by their health and well-being.

In line with this, the university will be holding the Annual Physical Examination (APE), set on March 15 (Thursday) and 16 (Friday). In coordination with Intellicare, onsite mobile services will be available at the Br. St. Miguel Hall on the said dates to conduct medical and laboratory tests from 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM. All permanent personnel and Intellicare members are required to submit themselves for medical tests.

Intellicare ID and/or DLSAU ID must be presented before the medical tests. Specimen containers are available at the University Clinic today.

Everyone is advised to consult our university physicians on check-up preparations (such as fasting and collection of specimen) and other health conditions that need to be considered prior to the APE.

All probationary and permanent personnel, including their dependents who are Intellicare members, who do not wish to take advantage of the onsite APE may request to undergo the APE at their preferred Intellicare Clinic. They must notify the Human Resource Development and Management Office (HRDMO) with the following information thru e-mail or by personally visiting the office:

1. Name of the Intellicare Member (Primary/Dependent)
2. Contact phone number
3. Preferred clinic

Please be informed that Intellicare requires at least 7 working days for the processing of the said requests. Please wait for the confirmation SMS from the HRDMO before proceeding to your preferred Intellicare Clinic for your APE.

Permanent personnel who are not Intellicare must undergo the APE at their preferred clinics/laboratories for as long as these clinics are DOH-accredited. They must also undergo the laboratory tests at their own expense. Concerned personnel can have their APE or X-Ray done during the abovementioned dates, but at the personnel's account:

Option 1:

1. Physical Examination
2. Chest X-Ray
3. Complete Blood Count
4. Urinalysis
5. Fecalalysis

Option 2:

1. Chest X-Ray only

The results of the abovementioned tests must be submitted to the University Clinic on or before March 30.
