Final Reminders for the Baccalaureate Mass and 71st Commencement Exercises

May 12 to May 13, 2018

1. Attendance in the scheduled rehearsals and Baccalaureate Mass is a requirement for participation in the 71st Commencement Exercises.
2. Dress Code for the following events:
 - a. Baccalaureate Mass & Recognition Rites- School Uniform
 - b. 71st Commencement Exercises - Semi-Formal attire for students, parents and guest
3. Each candidate is entitled two (2) tickets for the 71st Commencement Exercises for his parents/ spouse/relative/guardian.
4. Academic gowns will be distributed after the Recognition Rites.
5. Baccalaureate Mass will begin at exactly 8:00 a.m. Everyone is required to come on time.
6. The processional march for the 71st Commencement Exercises will begin at exactly 3:00 p.m. Those who will come late will not be allowed to join the processional march.
7. Each candidate is assigned his/her proper place in order of procession and seating arrangement during the events. No one is allowed to alter or exchange places.
8. Children below 10 years old are strictly prohibited to enter the venues.
9. Smoking and eating are not allowed during the events.
10. No one should be allowed to take pictures (whether camera or video cam) in the restricted areas during the ceremony. The university photographer and documentation committee are the only persons allowed to take pictures/video.
11. All cellphones should be switched to silent mode.
12. During the ceremony for both events, courtesy and proper decorum must be strictly observed to preserve the solemnity of the affair.
 - a. Refrain from loud and prolonged conversation.
 - b. While marching into the hall, no horsing or fooling around and talking. March properly. No stopping to greet relatives or visitors along the way.
13. Academic gowns and caps shall be returned to the supplier at the venue.
14. Those who have completed their clearances may claim their ID at the designated areas during the Commencement Exercises. Students are encouraged to fill-up all forms before they can claim their ID at the Alumni Office.
