June 2018 Agriculturist Licensure Examinations Results

Last June 2018

Ms. Elma Vocis Pulgarinas, a DLSAU-AgSI BS Agriculture alumna, placed 3rd in the June 2018 Agriculturist Licensure Examination. Ms. Pulgarinas, who received a rating of 87.00 percent, was tied in the 3rd place with two other test takers from the University of the Philippines – Los Baños and Central Bicol State of University of Agriculture – Camarines Sur.

Ms. Pulgarinas led five other successful test takers from our university and is among the 1 689 who passed the licensure examinations, out of the 4 428 who took the examinations last month. Our new Lasallian agriculturalists are Electro Gregorio Balbuena, Richard Besin Bersales, Nilarey Erojo Dahunan, Mark Anthony Rivera Paredes, Elma Vocis Pulgarinas, and Jeffrey Lagrosa Vidal.

To provide an objective assessment of our professors' planning and preparation, classroom management, instruction and professional responsibilities, the Online Faculty Performance Evaluation facility for Senior High School (SHS), Tertiary Education Department (TED), and Graduate Studies (GRAD) students will be available starting July 11 (Wednesday) and will remain open until July 27 (Friday). For Night College Program (NCP) students, the facility will be available from August 9 (Thursday) - 10 (Friday).

SHS students may access the facility at www.ebalwasyon-shs.dlsau.edu.ph, whereas TED, GRAD, and NCP students may log in at www.ebalwasyon.dlsau.edu.ph to evaluate their professors within the evaluation period. The facility can be readily accessed any time, from any desktop or mobile device, as long as it is connected to the Internet. Failure to evaluate will result to students being blocked from viewing their grades.

New SHS, TED, and GRAD students are requested to get their official DLSAU email accounts from the Information Technology Center to be able to access the online evaluation facility.
