2. For offices and faculty rooms, food and beverages are allowed, provided that all food wraps and leftovers are disposed in trash bins outside the said rooms. Used food containers, utensils, and dining wares need to be immediately washed after use or returned to the canteen as soon as possible.
3. Food and beverages are only allowed in Grade 3 classrooms, as students are encouraged to bring and eat their meals inside the classroom.

As such, interested students are encouraged to proceed to the Student Financial Assistance and Scholarship Office to secure, fill out, and submit the form until October 15 (Monday), 5 PM, for immediate processing.

UniFAST, the lead agency of the government that implements major programs of RA 10931 or the “Universal Access to Quality Tertiary Education Act”, provides grants-in-aid or educational financial assistance to students from households that are the poorest of the poor, poor and near poor in the Listahanan 2.0 of the Department of Social Welfare and Development through the TES.


