CAST/SHS Faculty Receives Recognition from DLSU for Paper Publications in CHED-Listed Journals

October 8, 2018

Mr. Jeconiah Louis Dreisbach, one of our College of Arts, Sciences, and Technology/Senior High School faculty members, was recognized by De La Salle University for having published his paper in a CHED-listed journal last October 8 at DLSU's Henry Sy Sr Hall. Mr. Dreisbach's paper, entitled "Disentangling the Rubrico and Dolalas Hypotheses on the Davao Filipino Language", was published in the *Recoletos Multidisciplinary Research Journal* in 2017.

Mr. Dreisbach is a Master of Arts candidate in DLSU's Filipino Department and is under the mentorship of Dr. F.P.A. Demeterio III. As of August 2018, he was able to publish his papers in *Malay (DLSU)* and *Kyoto Review of Southeast Asia (Center of Southeast Asian Studies, Kyoto University)*—both international peer-reviewed journals. His researches have also been presented in both local and international conferences.

On November 26-27 of this year, Mr. Dreisbach is set to present his latest publication, "Kritikal na Pagsasalin ng Isang Tulang Sosyopolitikal ni Jose Maria Sison" (*Malay*, 30[2], 2018, pp. 1-14) in the *Becoming Filipino: International Research Forum on the Philippines 2018* which will be held at La Trobe University in Australia.

PE examinations should be held within the usual assigned period from October 24-30, 2018.


