  - c. Recommendation from the Class Adviser
  - d. Filled out Application Form (Certificate of Candidacy)
  - e. Parent Consent Letter

3. Candidates for all SCB elective positions must be:
  - a. A bona fide student;
  - b. Of good academic standing, with a general average of 85 and above, without any failing grade during the 3rd grading period of the current school year;
  - c. Of good moral character and have not been subject to any major disciplinary sanction;
