## Double Birthday in Kagoshima

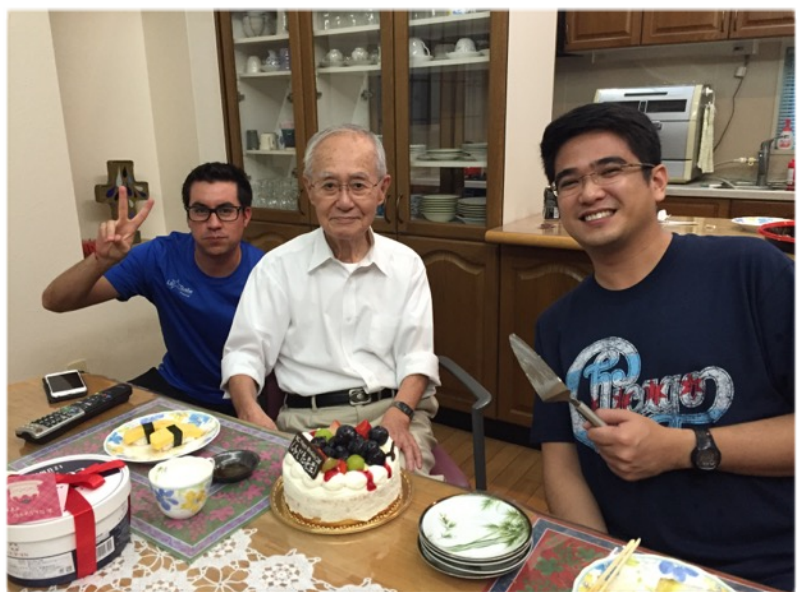


On September 5, Brother Hisao Fujita FSC, from the Community in Kagoshima, Japan, celebrated his 90th birthday.
